The National Commission for Further and Higher Education is constantly striving to ensure that all information delivered to the public is accurate, up to date and relevant. In accordance with Legal Notice 296 of 2012 on Licensing, Accreditation and Quality Assurance, the National Commission for Further and Higher Education maintains a Register of accredited Further and Higher Educational Institutions. This is carried out by working closely with new and established providers of Further and Higher Education to ensure that all the legal requirements are being adhered to and to provide an updated information service for the general public.

comprises three lists. The first one lists all licensed institutions in alphabetical order for ease of reference. The second list includes institutions with a regular licence that have fully satisfied all the necessary conditions stipulated in the legal notice. The third and final list includes institutions with a provisional licence, who are working towards fulfilment of all application conditions. By virtue of Article 11 of Legal Notice 296/2012, public Further or Higher education providers are deemed to have a licence and are subject to the same accreditation and quality assurance conditions as private institutions.

The Register is frequently updated to reflect on-going changes within the institutions and new licence-holders.
